CLUB AGM

Officers – The officers for the 2017 season, as confirmed at the AGM, are Chairman – Richard Varley, Secretary – Allison Storey and Treasurer – Jean Barras.

Fees – T he GPC's recommendation that the Club's Full Membership Fee be increased to £95 was approved by the meeting. This was it the light of a deficit of some £600 over the last season.

Honorary Vice President – In recognition of his many years service to the Club to the GPC, and particularly in recent years as Treasurer, the Chairman recommended, on behalf of the GPC, that Tom Harrison be made an Honorary Vice President of the club. This was fully supported by the membership.

Green Ranger – Bob Liddle has agreed to remain as Green Ranger with the support of a team of members who will carry out many of the day to day duties. This team is now working well carrying out daily swishing/maintenance. Our handyman has undertaken additional work including cutting, slitting and cleaning the ditches.

A new schedule of green rotation is proposed for next season. In any one week all games will be played in a single direction using three different rink positions, positioning of rink markers will be carried out by the Green Rangers team each day.

Bob reported that a leak in the watering system had been located and repaired. The leak had probably been there for at least 2 years.
