## CORONAVIRUS GUIDELINES - PART 1 - GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS - Version 02 - June 2020

These guidelines are intended to keep our members safe and are based on Government Regulations, Bowls England Guidelines and the specific requirements of Ponteland Bowling Club Your full co-operation is both requested and expected.

## **Changes highlighted**

- Do not visit the Club if you or any of your immediate family are showing any signs of the virus
- No visitors (restriction on Spectators removed).
- The allowable bowling format is a) an individual playing on their own on a rink, b) two individuals from different households on a single rink, markers are not allowed, c) from Sunday 21 June pairs play may take place on a rink but strict social distancing must be adhered to.
- A rink booking system is in operation and timing must be adhered to. The timing is arranged so that you vacate the site before the next bowlers arrive. Do not hang around for more than 15 minutes after playing and do not turn up to play more than 15 minutes before your booked time.
- When booking a rink all players names must be shown. By booking a rink all players are confirming that they have read, understood and are adhering to the Clubs guidelines.
- Rink booking sheets will be located in the external storage facility along with mats and jacks. Access to the storage box is by a combination lock using the same four numbers as the Clubhouse access code, i.e. omitting the C & X.
- The Clubhouse will be closed. One visit may be made to recover woods etc. from the locker room. These must then be taken off site. The toilets may be used but only in an absolute emergency.
- Dress appropriately for play and change shoes immediately before and after play.
- Take any food or drink you require with you and take empty bottles etc. home with you.
- Any sanitising wipes etc. which you may have used to be removed from site.
- Rink booking will be monitored to ensure an even distribution of games between members.
- Mats and jacks are available in the locked storage box. No other equipment can be used, no pushers, 2m sticks, ditch markers, scoreboards, chalk or measure.
