CORONAVIRUS GUIDELINES – PART 2 – GREEN USAGE –Version 02 – June2020

These guidelines are intended to keep our members safe and are based on Government Regulations, Bowls England Guidelines and the specific requirements of Ponteland Bowling Club

Your full co-operation is both requested and expected.

Changes highlighted

- At all times social distancing will be observed i.e. 2 metres apart.
- Only three rinks will be in use at any one time e.g. Rinks 1, 3 and 5 or 2, 4 and 6. This will be controlled by the Green Ranger. Members will not alter rink placings.
- Bowling will only take place in the direction of fence to Memorial Hall (and back) due to the difficulty of social distancing in front of the clubhouse.
- Only singles **or from Sunday 21 June pairs** play is allowed.
- Do not shake hands and do not touch opponent's bowls.
- Use two jacks, one at each end and this should be set by one player only during the session.
- Only one person to handle mat during a session.
- Mats and jacks to be sanitised before and after use and locked away at the end of each session in the storage facility provided.
- Sanitise padlock and any area of storage box touched. Any other handles, booking folder etc to be sanitised. **Any sanitising wipes etc. which you may have used to be removed from site.**
